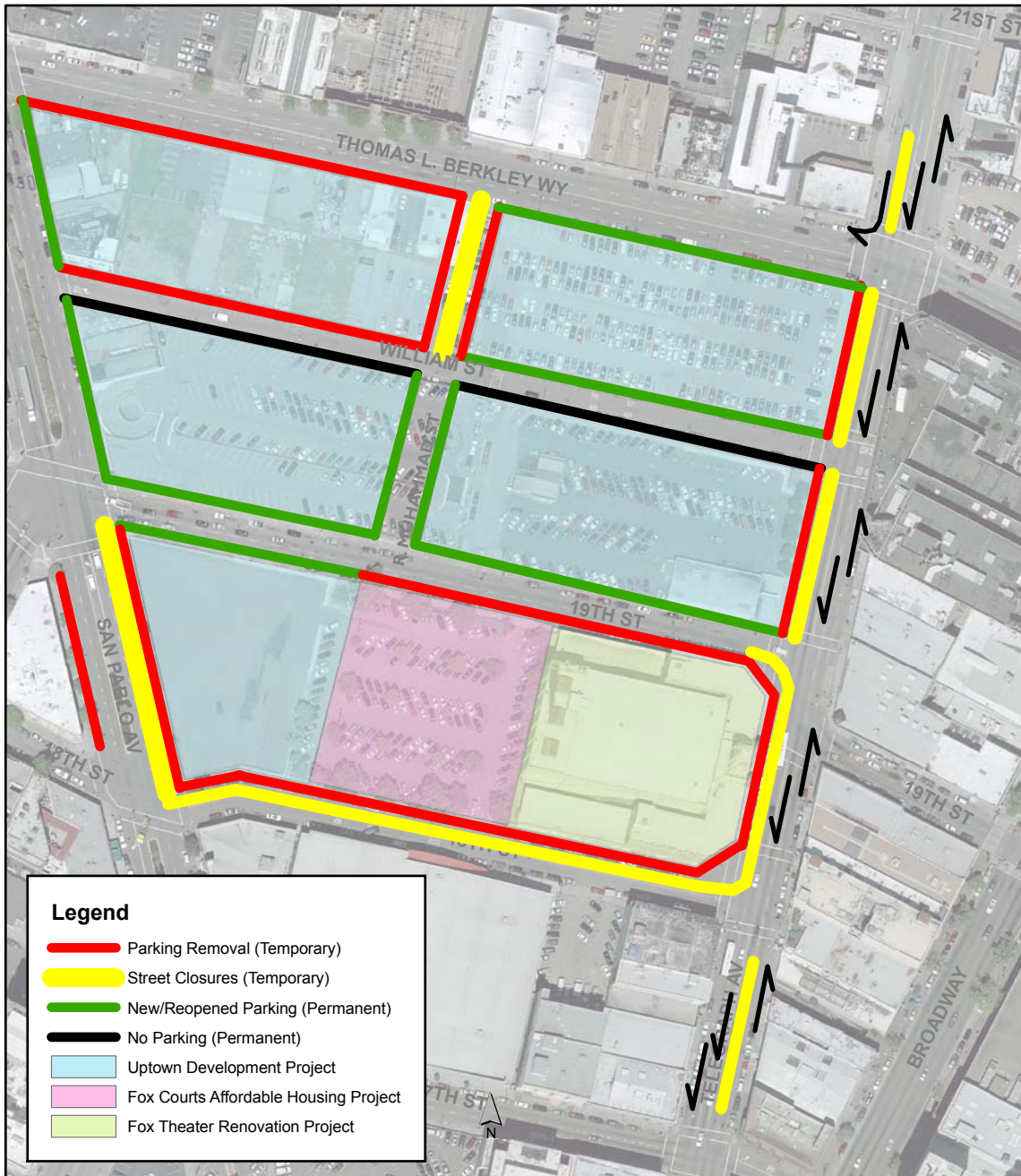

DOWNTOWN OAKLAND TEMPORARY PARKING AND STREET CLOSURES

TELEGRAPH PHASE I STREETScape PROJECT

Sep-08 - Dec-08: This streetscape project will add new sidewalks and bulb-outs to the areas in front of the Fox Theater and the Uptown Development Project. Parking and two lanes of traffic are temporarily closed on the western portion of Telegraph Ave from 17th to 20th (Thomas Berkley Way). Note that at least one north-bound and one south-bound lane of traffic is permitted in this area (see black arrows in the diagram). Sidewalks are also closed on the west side of Telegraph from 18th - 20th Streets.

UPTOWN DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Oct-06 - Nov-08: On-street parking in selected areas surrounding the Uptown Development Project has been reopened, or has been created (please see the areas marked in green in the diagram).

Aug-08: Williams Street has been fully reopened to traffic. New parking has been created on the north side of the street. No parking will be permitted on the south side.

OAKLAND SCHOOL FOR THE ARTS RELOCATION

Jun-07 - Dec-08: In order to allow the Fox Courts Affordable Housing Project to begin construction, the Oakland School for the Arts will be temporarily relocated to portables on San Pablo Avenue. Parking on both sides of San Pablo Ave from 18th to 19th Streets will be temporarily removed. Two travel lanes on the east side of the median will also be closed. There will be one north-bound and one south-bound travel lane on this block.

FOX COURTS AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROJECT

Aug-07 - Mar-09: On-Street parking in the area surrounding the Fox Courts Affordable Housing Project has been temporarily removed.

FOX THEATER PROJECT

Sep-06 - Jan-09: On-street parking in the area surrounding the Fox Theater has been temporarily removed.
